ROAD CLOSURES **SUNDAY 11TH NOVEMBER 2018**

DAYTIME **REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY SERVICE,** **PARADE & WREATH LAYING**

St. Augustine's Gate, Market Place, George Street,
Church Gate, Church Lane, Market Hill, Ivy Lane,
Waybain Lane, New Road/Fletcher Gate (between junctions with
Church Lane and St. Augustine's Gate)

The above roads are to be closed for a period of time for the Remembrance Day Parade, Church Service and Wreath Laying. Members, organisations and the Band of the Army Cadet Force will assemble in the Market Place at 10.30am and will parade to St. Augustine's Church for the Service of Remembrance. The Parade will leave the Market Place at 10.40am arriving at St. Augustine's Church at approximately 10.50am. At approximately 11.40am the Parade will reassemble and step off from Church Lane in order to process to the War memorial. At approximately 12 noon the Parade will reassemble and step off from Ivy Lane in order to process to the Market Place. The route will be via Church Lane, New Road and St. Augustine's Gate – a Temporary Road Closure Order under the Town Police Clauses Act has been agreed with the Legal Department of the East Riding of Yorkshire Council and the Humberside Police between the hours of **10.00am and 1.00pm.**

Please note that the roads will not be closed for the whole duration of this time but only to accommodate the assembling of the parade and the legs of the parade. The crucial times will be – 10.15am to 11.00am, 11.30am to 11.50am and approximately 12 noon to 1.00pm.

Remembrance Sunday this year marks 100 years since the Armistice that ended the Great War of 1914-18. The Council will mark this special anniversary with a new memorial and a celebration of peace. In the evening we will be celebrating this, starting on Market Hill around 6.15pm when the event will begin with songs from our two primary schools. Following the Last Post, the Mayor will light the beacon at 7.00pm as part of the national Beacon of Light celebration. The new Armistice Memorial to those who served from Hedon will also be unveiled. Following this, St. Augustine's Church will host a celebration of wartime songs and war poetry with performances by the Hedon Mixed Voice Choir, Hedon Handbell Ringers and even a group of your Councillors. There will be refreshments available and exhibits on the "The Great War" and "Hedon 100 years ago".

Road Closures for this event will be Market Hill, Ivy Lane, Waybain, Church Lane and Church Gate – 4.00pm until 8.00pm.

Hedon Town Council has arranged through its Safety Co-ordinator, the East Riding of Yorkshire Council and the Humberside Police, to close the above roads to facilitate these events. It would be appreciated, therefore, if you could make alternative arrangements to avoid the closures. Emergency vehicles will have passage through. Road signs will be placed around the town to warn of the closure.

Thank you for your co-operation and we trust that these closures will not cause you too much inconvenience.
